



## 2024 Spettacolo Concorso Application

Thank you for applying to compete in the 2024 *Spettacolo Concorso*. If you are applying to enter more than one car, complete a separate application form for each car.

To apply for acceptance to the *Concorso* competition, you must complete and submit this form by **Friday 1st November**. You will receive an email acknowledging receipt of your application.

To help assess your application, *Concorso* Director Bruce Roberts will contact you to learn about the story and condition of your car. You will be advised by email if your vehicle is accepted for *Concorso* judging by **Friday 8th November**. You will also be advised if your application is not accepted.

The entry fee for *Concorso* is \$85. The fee is only payable if your application is accepted. The notification of acceptance will also advise you how to make the payment. Payment must be made by Wednesday, 13 November 2024.

### Please note:

- *Concorso* is only open to bona fide members of any Division of AROCA (VIC, NSW, QLD, SA, or WA).
- It is a condition of entry that ALL cars judged for *Concorso* on Saturday 23 November must be displayed in the *Concorso* area at Spettacolo on Sunday 24 November at 10.00am.
- Entry to *Concorso* is restricted to vehicles built prior to, or during, 2004.
- Post 2004 Alfa models such as 159, Brera, Brera Spider, Mito, Modern Giulietta, 4C, modern Giulia, Stelvio or Tonale are NOT eligible for *Concorso*.
- Modified vehicles, fitted with non-original equipment wheels, aftermarket accessories, and competition safety and speed equipment are only eligible for the MODIFIED class.
- Judges will inspect lights, turn signals, horn, wipers, paint, chrome, detailing of the exterior, interior and boot, cleanliness and detailing of the engine bay, under wheel arches and – in the case of a tie – the chassis will be inspected on a hoist.
- Except for trailered race cars, all *Concorso* entries must be driven to the event on full road or historic permit registered plates.

## Vehicle Class

---

You can enter your car in only one Class. Please tick one Class only.

- 1. Vintage**  
Cars made before 1950.
- 2. 1900, all 750 and 101 Giuliettas, 2000/2600 and TZ models**
- 3. All 105s including Giulia, Coupe, Spider, Montreal, Junior Z models**
- 4. All 900 Alfasud, Sud Sprint and Alfa 33 models**
- 5. All 116 Alfetta and Giulietta models**
- 6. All post 116 models**  
Including Alfa 90, 75, ES30, 916 cars pre-1999 eligible for historic permit plates.
- 7. Modern Classic**  
Cars built from 1999 to 2004 including 916, 147, 156, 166 on full registration.
- 8. Preservation**  
This class is first judged for originality/authenticity. Only **non-restored** cars made before 2005 that are clean, fully operational examples in well preserved original condition are eligible. Work done for roadworthy, safety, routine maintenance, and minor cosmetic/structural/operational work to exterior, chassis, interior and mechanicals repairs following accident damage are permitted and **must be noted below**. Vehicles that are seriously deteriorated "barn finds", or static, non-running cars are not eligible.


- 9. Modified**  
A pre-2005 car modified in body, interior or mechanicals. For example, fast road and track cars.
