

### Alfisti Autumn Tour 2024

the Post Alfesta Tom

(Lakes Entrance to Lake Burley Griffin)



Monday 1st April to Friday 5th April 2024

This is a call for *Expressions of Interest* to join the Tour in April 2024

The 2024 <u>Alfisti Autumn Tour</u> (aka the *Post Alfesta Tour*) will run from **Lakes Entrance** on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> April to **Canberra** on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> April. The Tour is jointly organised by the Alpine Alfisti Association and AROCA Victoria. The Tour will run through the Victorian Alps to the Riverina and then back through the Snowy Mountains to Canberra. Alfisti Tours have a reputation for visiting iconic locations, following fabulous roads with sensational scenery, while enjoying gastronomic delights and typical Alfisti camaraderie. The proposed Tour itinerary is as follows:

#### Day 1 | Monday 1st April | Lakes Entrance to Bright

Into the mountains and over the top!

AM: After a mid-morning start, follow the Great Alpine Rd, stopping at Swifts Creek then on to Hotham Heights for lunch; PM: Continue over Mt Hotham and then down through Harrietville to Bright.

This leg can be both exciting and demanding. It heads over the highest parts of Victoria along windy, narrow, but well-maintained roads, and the scenery is fabulous!

#### Day 2 | Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> April | Bright to Albury

AM: From Bright, we head back east towards Mt Beauty and through Tawonga Gap. If the weather, traffic and our schedule is on track, we'll stop at Sullivans Lookout (which overlooks the Kiewa Valley and towards Mt Bogong, Victoria's highest peak) on the way through. We'll then follow the Kiewa River north and double back along the aptly named Happy Valley Road to Myrtleford, then we head north through Stanley and to historic Beechworth for lunch.

After lunch we'll be heading through Chiltern via Howlong to Albury. But you might want to spend some time exploring

After lunch we'll be heading through Chiltern via Howlong to Albury. But you might want to spend some time exploring historic Beechworth or head to Rutherglen to check out a few of the region's iconic wineries. Either way, you will need to find your way to Albury for the second overnight stop.

#### Day 3 | Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> April | Albury to Tumut

AM: We'll follow the mighty Murray from Albury, crossing Lake Hume over the iconic Iron Bridge, to Tintaldra before heading north via Tooma to Tumbarumba, for lunch at a beaut little winery/restaurant.

PM: Either: drive via Batlow, of apple fame, to Tumut; or, take a detour enroute to Tumut and visit the historic Adelong Falls Gold Mill Ruins along the way. Overnight is in Tumut.

#### Day 4 | Thursday 4th April | Tumut to Jindabyne

AM: Follow the Snowy Mountains Highway – the coolest road in the country – via Talbingo, Kiandra and Adaminaby to Jindabyne. But you can't just go past Adaminaby. It is mandatory for every traveller to take a selfie with the Big Trout! Obligations addressed, we'll then head to the Snowy Hydro's Museum in Adaminaby which has many large and impressive exhibits from the Snowy Mountains Hydro project. From Adaminaby we head south to Jindabyne - along a road that can only be described as sensational - for the final overnight stop.

#### Day 5 | Friday 5th April | Jindabyne to Canberra

AM: The early risers have the option to head out to Charlotte Pass to take in the wonders of the Snowy Mountains scenery and Mt Kosciuszko in particular. It's about two hours for the return trip, but the road and scenery are fabulous. The rest may opt for a sleep-in and a late breaky, or go for a wander around town or by the lake. Whichever you choose, we'll all meet for a late morning tea before departing for Dalgety for an early lunch.

PM: After lunch we'll head to Cooma where the Cooma Car Club hosts a magnificent museum dedicated to classic cars and memorabilia. From Cooma, we head for Canberra, an hour and a bit away.

Saturday 6th April: Tour free day! Shopping &/or prep the chariot for Auto Italia

Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> April: Auto Italia @ Queanbeyan Park

#### **Club Permit Scheme**

The VicRoads Club Permit Scheme (CPS) allows members of AROCA to make limited use of historic vehicles on the road network. The club has appointed a Club Permit Officer (CPO) as administrator for the scheme and he will process club permit applications and renewals.

#### A Road Worthy Certificate is required for all new applications to VicRoads.

Members now need to provide us with the following before we can sign-off on a Club Permit Application Form.

- 1. The new Club Permit Application form (original to be supplied to the club).
- 2. The Vehicle Eligibility form (original to be supplied to the club)
- 3. The original or a copy of a valid Road Worthy Certificate
- 4. Dated photographs of the vehicle, this will include, Front, Driver's side, Rear, Driving position (driver's side with driver's door open) and VIN/Chassis number (if possible).

The club permit application form and vehicle eligibility form must be downloaded from the VicRoads website – <u>click here for the page</u>.

VicRoads will only process paper forms with original signatures – therefore we cannot process application or renewal forms electronically by email. Please follow the instructions below to send the original forms with a stamped return envelope.

#### **Roadworthy Certificates**

A Roadworthy Certificate can be obtained from any VicRoads Licenced Roadworthy Tester. To access the VicRoads list of RWC Testers Click Here.

#### **New Permit Applications**

The procedures regarding how to apply for, or renew, Club Plates have changed.

- 1. Applicants must be a current Club member and able to prove ownership of the vehicle.
- 2. Obtain a Roadworthy Certificate from an authorised tester.
- 3. Complete the Club Permit Application Form and Vehicle Eligibility Form (forms can be downloaded from the VicRoads website).
- 4. Select the 45 or 90 day option.
- 5. Provide a stamped self-addressed envelope.
- 6. Take digital colour photos (not hard copies) of the car showing front, rear, driver's side, and with the driver's door open. For convertibles, also take one photo with the roof off .
- 7. Send Roadworthy Certificate, proof of ownership, completed VicRoads forms and the stamped self-addressed envelope to "CPS, PO Box 7076, Banyule Vic 3084".
- 8. Email the digital photos to "cps@alfaclubvic.org.au" advising the permit application is in the mail.
- 9. The signed forms will be returned to you in the stamped, self-addressed envelope.
- 10. Take the forms and payment to VicRoads who will then issue you with your new Club Plate

#### **Permit Renewals**

#### The easiest way to renew is online, as follows:

- 1. Go on the Vic Roads website and open an account;
- 2. Once your account is open that will automatically pick up any fully registered vehicles in your name, but it may not pick up the club plated vehicles;
- 3. If your Club plated vehicle is not picked up, manually add your club plated vehicle to your account. It usually takes Vic Roads 24 hours to add it to your account;
- 4. Once your club plated vehicle is added to your account, email a copy of the Club plate renewal form to cps @alfaclubvic.org.au;
- 5. The CPS Officer will then email you a completed and signed Club Endorsement Form, provided you are a financial member of the Club:
- 6. Once you have the signed Club Endorsement Form, go into your Vic Roads account and next to the club plated registration there should be a "Pay" button. Click on that and you will then be asked to upload the Club Endorsement Form; you can then pay your club registration by following the instructions.

#### Renewing by Mail;

- 1. Applicants must be a current Club member and still the registered owner of the vehicle.
- 2. On receipt of your CPS Registration Renewal from VicRoads, sign where required.
- 3. Select the 45 or 90 day option.
- 4. Obtain a stamped, self-addressed, envelope.
- 5. Send renewal form and stamped, self-addressed, envelope to "CPS, PO Box 7076 Banyule Vic 3084".
- 6. The CPS Officer will check the membership records and then return the signed renewal form to you if you are a current financial member.
- 7. Upon receipt of the signed renewal form, take the signed renewal form and payment to VicRoads.
- 8. The renewal form has the option of allowing the vehicle owner to pay the renewal fee by enclosing a cheque made payable to Vic Roads. If you want to do that, enclose a cheque payable to Vic Roads, but ensure that the stamped, self-addressed, envelope you enclose is addressed to Vic Roads. The registration renewal form also requires your signature, so be sure to sign it as the permit holder as well. The CPS officer will then mail the registration renewal form to Vic Roads on your behalf.

#### Renewing in Person;

You are welcome to attend the Club meeting, which occurs every second Wednesday of each month, and seek out the CPS officer for his signature, but be sure to have your current Club Membership card with you to prove you are a financial member.

If the CPS officer is not in attendance, there will be someone else present from the Club's Committee who will be authorised to sign your renewal form.

Permit Validity

#### If you allow your AROCA membership to lapse, you will then be driving an unregistered vehicle.

AROCA is required to notify VicRoads of any AROCA member using a club permit who becomes unfinancial. If you have a club permit it is important that you pay your membership fees or your vehicle will be deemed unregistered and illegal to operate on the road.

It is also a requirement of the scheme that AROCA notifies VicRoads of any misuse of CPS log books and/or CPS registered vehicles.
