

Notice to Members

Recently, MYCCO (the online system that drives our website and club management system) experienced a data breach. A computer hacker bypassed MYCCO's security and accessed a very small portion of the overall data held within MYCCO. The information obtained is encrypted and not displayed in plain text, making it unreadable.

We have been assured by MYCCO that the hacker did not access any AROCA Victoria members' data.

The owner and developer of MYCCO has treated this breach very seriously. As a precaution, they have disabled any possible means of interacting with its database via the AROCA Vic website.

This means that logging into the members' area is temporarily disabled, as is submitting inquiries via the contact form, completing online membership applications, or RSVPing to events.

Security upgrades to MYCCO are currently underway and are prioritized over all other work. It is a significant undertaking, and we have not yet been given a completion date. The AROCA Victoria Committee are also taking steps to secure our data, and will be reviewing, and where possible upgrading, our own security protocols.

We will continue to inform you of any relevant updates as we receive them.

AROCA Victoria - Treasurer's Report

Greetings all. Other than on the 35+ degrees days, it has been great to see so many club permit cars on the roads around Melbourne and the drivers enjoying them.

Our financial year ends on 31 December and in mid-January the MYOB financial statements and accompanying schedules were provided to our Auditor as required by our Constitution. The audit will be completed by our February committee meeting and signed off by the committee. The financials are then returned to the Auditor for signing and a signed set is then emailed to members in early March, prior to the AGM on Wednesday 12 March.

At the AGM we shall discuss them and offer them for approval. Assuming that happens, in the weeks following the AGM we lodge our annual return with Consumer Affairs Victoria and pay the \$60 filing fee. That will conclude our obligations for the 31 December 2024 year.

The financials show we are in a strong financial position. One does not measure a club by its bank balance but being in a sound position helps us to fund essential but loss-making activities such as Spettacolo, the catering at general meetings and from a cash flow perspective, prepaying track hires. Phillip Island insist on 50% of their \$20K a day track hire well in advance – we have paid 2 lots of \$10K recently, one for our July 2025 event and a second one for our November 2025 event. We attract about 100 entries to those events which covers our costs. However, from a timing viewpoint, it is a large cash flow commitment to have made in January 2025.

At the AGM all committee positions are declared vacant. Some folk may be re-standing, others will not. I shall be in the latter category. We shall (politely) need to find a new Treasurer – with 750 single members and 250 family members we are a big club, meaning there is quite a pool of resources to scout. I have drafted a Situations Vacant ad which appears elsewhere in this on-line newsletter.

AROCA's **NEW** mailing address for ALL CPS correspondence is:

CPS Applications c/o B Baum, PO Box 4251, CROYDON HILLS, Vic. 3136

(Should you use the old address, AusPost will just return your mail to you.)

Also, please remember that:

- A CPS vehicle must be Registered with VicRoads. (The CPS Permit is NOT a registration certificate!)
- You must be a current member of AROCA for your Club Permit to be valid.
- You are required to complete a logbook entry for every trip BEFORE your trip commences.
- You must carry your Club Membership card with you in your CPS car at all times.
- If you sell the car, the permit is <u>not</u> transferred. (The new owner must apply for their own Permit).
- The VicRoads website makes the CPS conditions very clear, but if you are in doubt, please ask!





Club Permit Scheme

The VicRoads Club Permit Scheme (CPS) allows members of AROCA to make limited use of historic vehicles on the road network. The club has appointed a Club Permit Officer (CPO) as administrator for the scheme and he will process club permit applications and renewals.

A Road Worthy Certificate is required for all new applications to VicRoads.

Members now need to provide us with the following before we can sign-off on a Club Permit Application Form.

- 1. The new Club Permit Application form (original to be supplied to the club).
- 2. The Vehicle Eligibility form (original to be supplied to the club)
- 3. The original or a copy of a valid Road Worthy Certificate
- 4. Dated photographs of the vehicle, this will include, Front, Driver's side, Rear, Driving position (driver's side with driver's door open) and VIN/Chassis number (if possible).

The club permit application form and vehicle eligibility form must be downloaded from the VicRoads website – click here for the page.

VicRoads will only process paper forms with original signatures – therefore we cannot process application or renewal forms electronically by email. Please follow the instructions below to send the original forms with a stamped return envelope.

Roadworthy Certificates

A Roadworthy Certificate can be obtained from any VicRoads Licenced Roadworthy Tester. To access the VicRoads list of RWC Testers Click Here.

New Permit Applications

The procedures regarding how to apply for, or renew, Club Plates have changed.

- 1. Applicants must be a current Club member and able to prove ownership of the vehicle.
- 2. Obtain a Roadworthy Certificate from an authorised tester.
- 3. Complete the Club Permit Application Form and Vehicle Eligibility Form (forms can be downloaded from the VicRoads website).
- 4. Select the 45 or 90 day option.
- 5. Provide a stamped self-addressed envelope.
- 6. Take digital colour photos (not hard copies) of the car showing front, rear, driver's side, and with the driver's door open. For convertibles, also take one photo with the roof off.
- 7. Send Roadworthy Certificate, proof of ownership, completed VicRoads forms and the stamped self-addressed envelope to: *PO Box 4251, CROYDON HILLS, Vic. 3136*
- 8. Email the digital photos to "cps@alfaclubvic.org.au" advising the permit application is in the mail.
- 9. The signed forms will be returned to you in the stamped, self-addressed envelope.
- 10. Take the forms and payment to VicRoads who will then issue you with your new Club Plate On receipt of your new CPS plates, please notify AROCA of your new registration number via email to: cps@alfaclubvic.org.au.

Club Permit Scheme - Permit Renewals

The easiest way to renew CPS is online, as follows:

- 1. Go on the Vic Roads website and open an account;
- 2. Once your account is open that will automatically pick up any fully registered vehicles in your name, but it may not pick up the club plated vehicles;
- 3. If your Club plated vehicle is not picked up, manually add your club plated vehicle to your account. It usually takes Vic Roads 24 hours to add it to your account;
- 4. Once your club plated vehicle is added to your account, email a copy of the Club plate renewal form to cps @alfaclubvic.org.au;
- 5. The CPS Officer will then email you a completed and signed Club Endorsement Form, provided you are a financial member of the Club:
- 6. Once you have the signed Club Endorsement Form, go into your Vic Roads account and next to the club plated registration there should be a "Pay" button. Click on that and you will then be asked to upload the Club Endorsement Form <u>and</u> registration renewal certificate (signed by you); you can then pay your club registration by following the instructions.

Renewing CPS by mail;

- 1. Applicants must be a current Club member and still the registered owner of the vehicle.
- 2. On receipt of your CPS Registration Renewal from VicRoads, sign where required.
- 3. Select the 45 or 90 day option.
- 4. Obtain a stamped, self-addressed, envelope.
- 5. Send renewal form and stamped, self-addressed, envelope to: PO Box 4251, CROYDON HILLS, Vic. 3136.
- 6. The CPS Officer will check the membership records and then return the signed renewal form to you if you are a current financial member.
- 7. Upon receipt of the signed renewal form, take the signed renewal form and payment to VicRoads.
- 8. The renewal form has the option of allowing the vehicle owner to pay the renewal fee by enclosing a cheque made payable to Vic Roads. If you want to do that, enclose a cheque payable to Vic Roads, but ensure that the stamped, self-addressed, envelope you enclose is addressed to Vic Roads. The registration renewal form also requires your signature, so be sure to sign it as the permit holder as well. The CPS officer will then mail the registration renewal form to Vic Roads on your behalf.

Renewing CPS in person;

You are welcome to attend the Club meeting, which occurs every second Wednesday of each month, and seek out the CPS officer for his signature, but be sure to have your current Club Membership card with you to prove you are a financial member.

If the CPS officer is not in attendance, there will be someone else present from the Club's Committee who will be authorised to sign your renewal form.

Club Permit Scheme - Permit Validity

If you allow your AROCA membership to lapse, you will then be driving an unregistered vehicle.

AROCA is required to notify VicRoads of any AROCA member using a club permit who becomes unfinancial. If you have a club permit it is important that you pay your membership fees or your vehicle will be deemed unregistered and illegal to operate on the road.

It is also a requirement of the scheme that AROCA notifies VicRoads of any misuse of CPS log books and/or CPS registered vehicles.
